

# New Erasmus+ Project at our University!

2022 to be another successful year for Erasmus+ Projects at the Institute for Modern Philologies.

On February 18, a bilateral agreement concerning Social Skills in Blended Learning for Better Student Achievement - KA220-SCH-AB540773 Erasmus+ project was signed by our University's Rector - dr hab. inż. Jacek Nowakowski, prof. ATH. The SocialBlend Project is a 3-year Erasmus+ funded initiative aimed at developing various online tools for teachers aimed at increasing the level of Transversal Skills development in an online teaching and learning environment. The project starts in March 2022 and ends in June, 2024.

The partners involved in this project are strongly connected by their common interest in the topics of responsible citizenship and community building at school. These topics are perceived as necessary components to a greater common goal which is the effective contribution to global efforts that address global issues (UN SDGs). Thus the project aims to raise awareness on the importance of social skills in blended learning.

The consortium of 7 project partners from Belgium, Cyprus, Finland, Hungary, Slovakia, Romania and Poland wants to increase awareness at all levels from students, teachers, educational experts to policymakers and enhance both students and teachers' digital skills in specific online educational situations. The project is believed to maximise the benefits of integrated cooperation and networking at the transnational level and provide the highest standards for blended education.
