REGISTRATION FOR BOOK RENTAL

1. A prerequisite for enrolment is a valid student ID.
2. You should go to the **Book Lending Department on the ground floor of building L, room 001**, in order to generate an account number and password, while completing the registration formalities (consent to the processing of personal data, sign a declaration of entry to the Library). Please read the Regulations on Sharing the Collections (available on the website of the ATH Library) containing detailed information on the use of library collections.
3. Using the book ordering instructions, place an order for the necessary publications.
4. Within 5 days, the Reader should collect the ordered books from the Book Lending Department.

BOOK LENDING DEPARTMENT IN A NUTSHELL...

- We borrow books after ordering them electronically.
- The deadline for returning the book is 4 weeks.
- You can have 11 books on your account.
- A one-time extension is possible /online, by phone or at the Book Lending Department/.
- Remember to return the borrowed materials on time.
- For books not returned on time, a fee of PLN 1 is collected for each week of delay.
- Books borrowed by another reader can be reserved.
- Reservation books must be ordered electronically before borrowing.

GENERAL READING ROOM IN A NUTSHELL

Readers use the collections in open access. The materials are arranged on bookshelves thematically according to departments and marked with appropriate colours:

- Handheld library (bookshelves No. 1-12)
- Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences (bookshelves No. 13-44, 50, 81, 95-97)
- Faculty of Management and Transport (bookshelves No. 45-72)
- Faculty of Mechanical Engineering and Computer Science (bookshelves No. 73-80, 82-94, 98-100)
- Faculty of Materials, Civil and Environmental Engineering (bookshelves No. 101-132)
- Faculty of Health Sciences (bookshelves No. 117-119, 125-132)

To find the book you need, check its location in the directory.

Examples of book signatures:

12135/Cz/Mag – the book is in the Reading Room, it is given by the librarian on duty

21549/Cz/132/I – the book is in the General Reading Room (open access) on the 132nd shelf, 1st bookshelf counting from the top

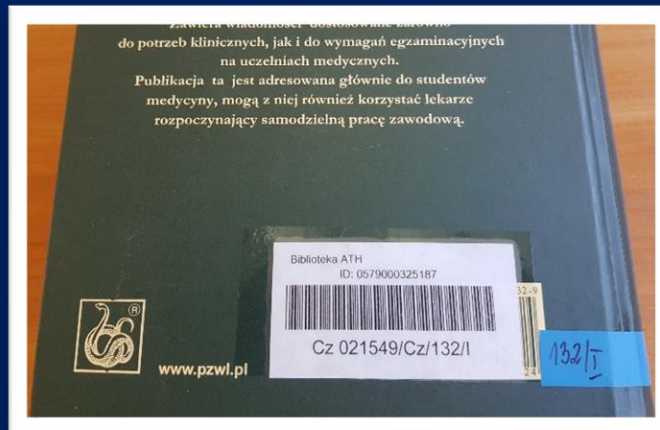

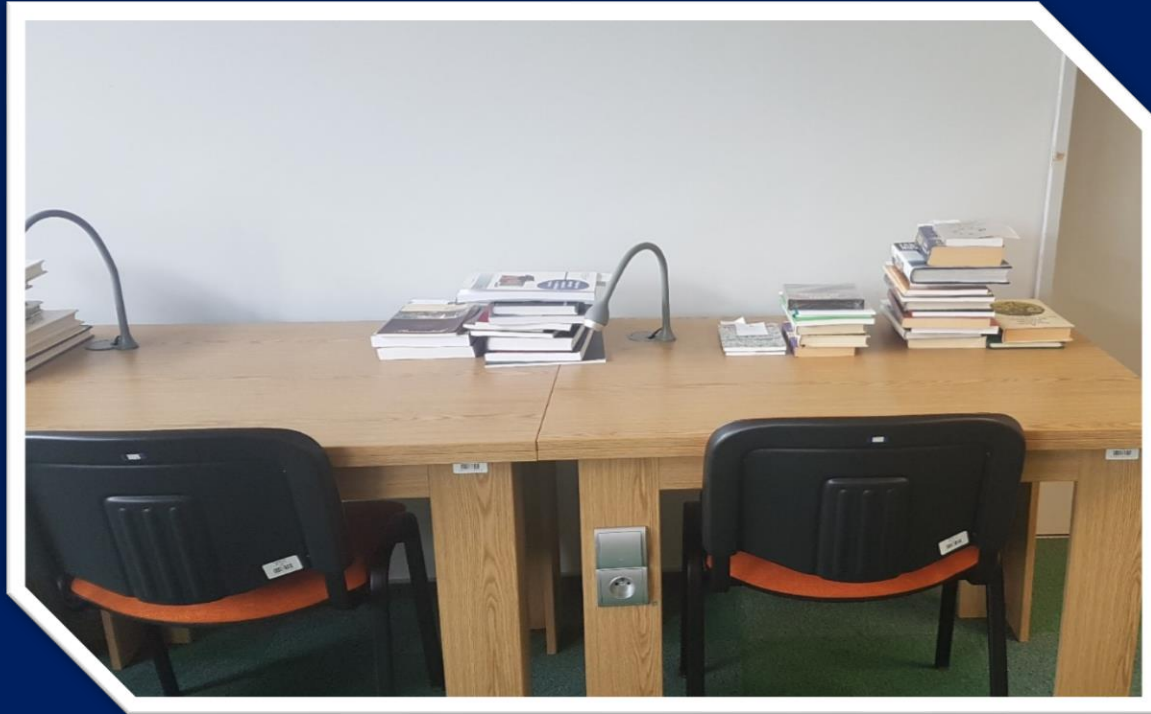




After using the books, put them not on the bookshelves, but on the tables



THE MAGAZINE READING ROOM IN A NUTSHELL ...

The Magazine Reading Room houses Polish and foreign magazines and newspapers. The titles along with the range of available years can be searched through the catalog.
